Abstract: *Cherax setosus* is one of four *Cherax* species in Australia with lateral propodal setation on the ventral surface of the propodal palm. All four species have an intriguing and interwoven history. This redescription utilising modern morphological information will help clarify the species identification and its relationships with the other similar species.
