## A GUIDE TO AUSTRALIA'S SPINY FRESHWATER CRAYFISH

### Publication

This publication refers to Australia's *Euastacus* Crayfish which are the largest of the 10 genera of Australian freshwater crayfish. We cover the full 50 *Euastacus* species found in Australia, from the iconic Giant Murray Lobsters (*Euastacus armatus*) that are recreationally fished to the exceedingly rare tiny species, like *Euastacus madae* from the NSW/Qld coastal border region. These uniquely Australian mainland crayfish range from Cooktown in far north Queensland to Wilsons Promontory in Victoria, the southernmost point of the Australian mainland. Many are found in or around major population centres, making them well known to many people. For example, *Euastacus spinifer* and *Euastacus australasiensis* are found throughout the Sydney region. *Euastacus yarraensis* is found around Melbourne and *Euastacus sulcatus* from the outskirts of Brisbane.
